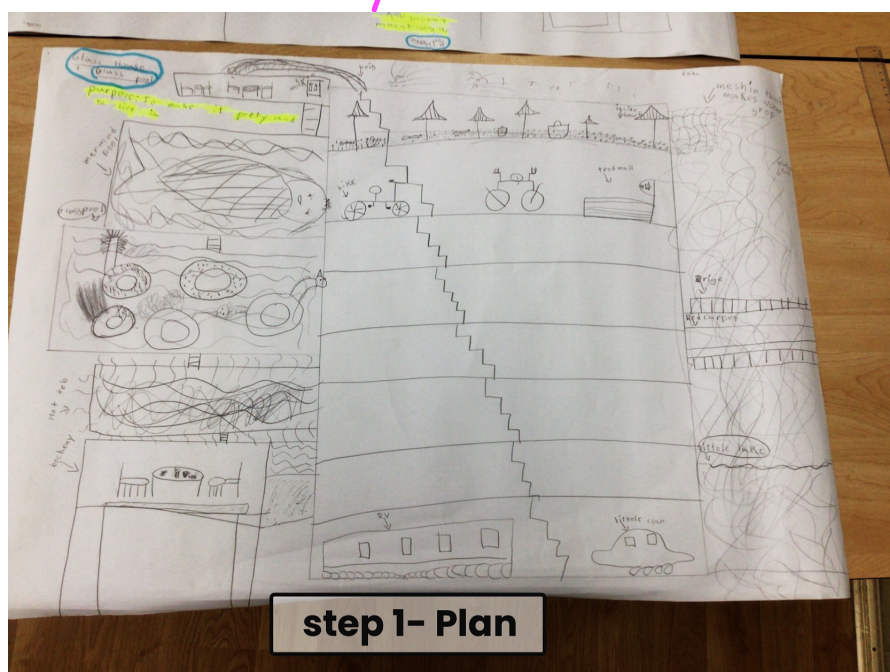

The Glass house -Glass pool

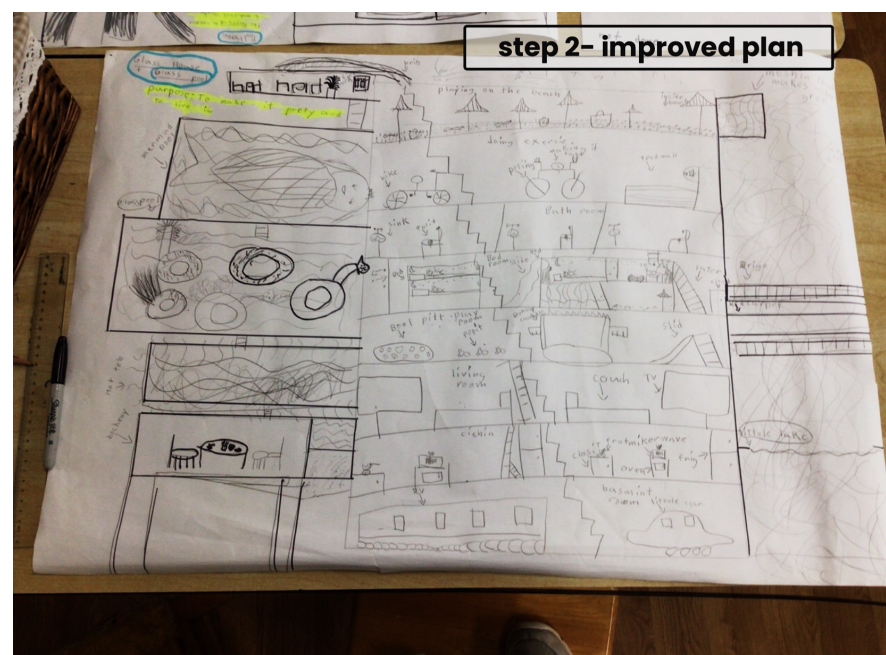

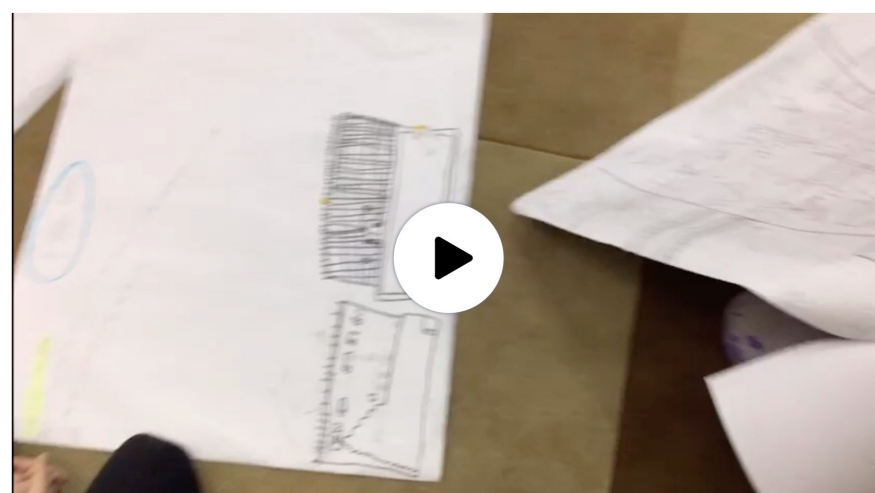
I started drawing down my ideas so when I build my structure and I forget something I can look at my plan.

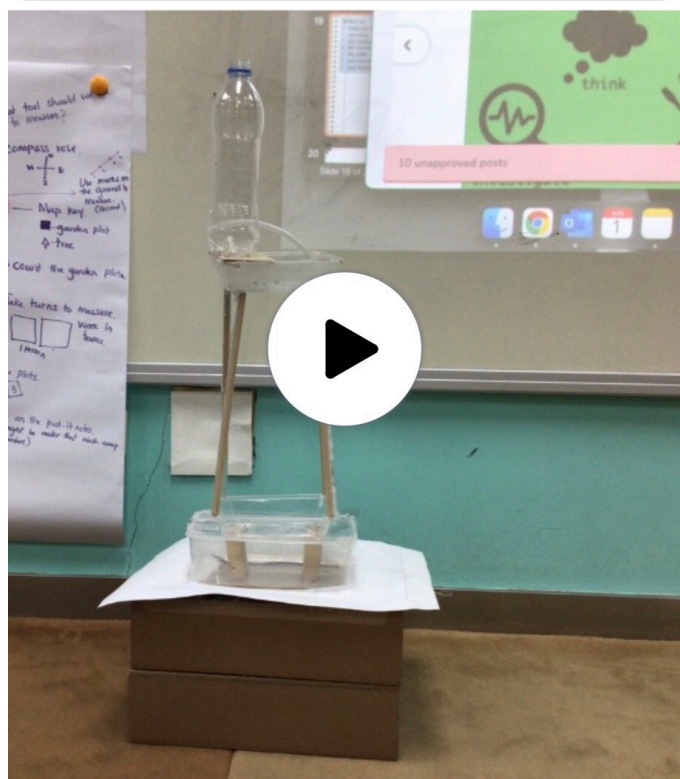
